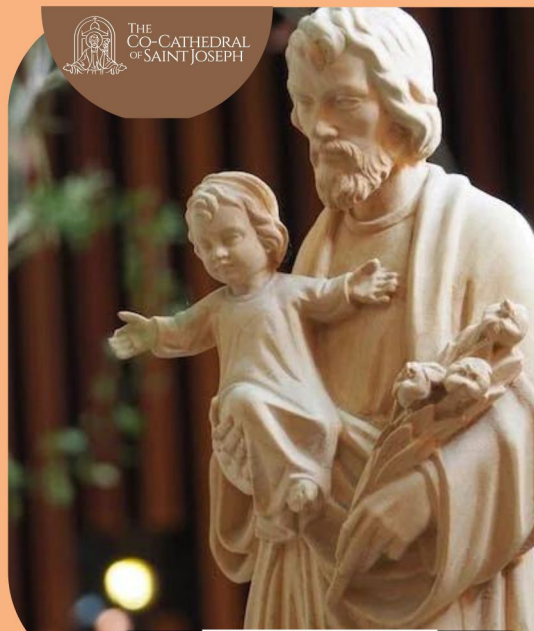

SEVEN SUNDAY OF ST. JOSEPH (SIXTH)

Sixth sorrow: And he rose and took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel. But when he heard that Archelaus reigned over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there (Mt 2:22).

Sixth joy: And he went and dwelt in a city called Nazareth, that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled, "He shall be called a Nazarene" (Mt 2:23).

"THE LIFE OF St. Joseph was not free of difficulties, great or small. In fact, the custom of living with greater devotion the seven Sundays leading up to his feast was born of a desire to contemplate his seven joys and also his seven sorrows. These sorrows include, for example, when Jesus at the age of twelve stayed behind in the Temple in Jerusalem without his parents' knowledge."

Baptism: Baptisms are available in English, Spanish and Creole. Parents may schedule their child's baptism by contacting the parish office.

Holy Matrimony: Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months prior to a wedding date. Contact the rectory for an appointment with a priest or deacon. Weddings can be scheduled in English, Spanish and Creole.



Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament is available for any baptized Catholic who is seriously ill or suffering from the effects of advanced age. It is also recommended for anyone who is going to undergo serious surgery. Please call the rectory to schedule an appointment for a priest to visit your home. A communal celebration of this sacrament will be scheduled twice a year.
