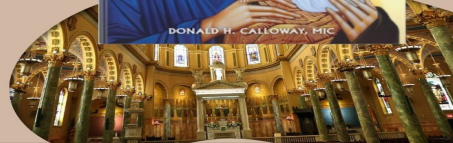
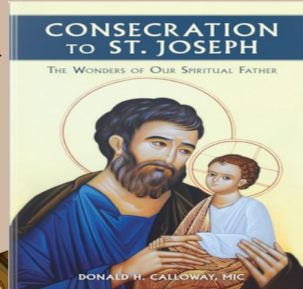

**Baptism:** Baptisms are available in English, Spanish and Creole. Parents may schedule their child's baptism by contacting the parish office.

**Holy Matrimony:** Marriage arrangements must be made at least six months prior to a wedding date. Contact the rectory for an appointment with a priest or deacon. Weddings can be scheduled in English, Spanish and Creole.



**Anointing of the Sick:** This sacrament is available for any baptized Catholic who is seriously ill or suffering from the effects of advanced age. It is also recommended for anyone who is going to undergo serious surgery. Please call the rectory to schedule an appointment for a priest to visit your home. A communal celebration of this sacrament will be scheduled twice a year.
